The position is responsible for accurate material flow and inventory accuracy. This position supports the Integrated Supply Chain. The Production and Inventory Control Planner will work closely with the floor personnel, distribution centers, and material analysts to obtain and analyze cycle counts.

The **Production & Inventory Control Planner** will also be involved in the product life cycle management process. They will help minimize obsolescence and coordinate the changes on the materials side. They will also be responsible for handling and devising solutions to eliminate slow moving inventory.

The **Production & Inventory Control Planner** will utilize reports to manage and measure the cycle counting program and inventory to increase our Order to Cash metrics.

Other responsibilities include working with manufacturing and distribution through continuous improvement projects to maximize inventory accuracy. This position must develop and maintain excellent relationships with internal customers. Regular interaction with all levels across multiple organizations is required.

Responsibilities

- Rollout and enforce new cycle counting procedure
- Conduct and direct daily cycle counts
- Analyze daily cycle counts and correct discrepancies
- Report and distribute cycle counting metrics
- Ensure accurate departmental transactions are processed in accordance with established system procedures
- Perform root cause analysis on out of tolerance counts and develop continuous improvement projects to eliminate inaccuracies
- Ensure inventory records are updated to reflect stock removed as scrap, rejected materials, or as stock returns.
- Generate Purchase Orders for MRO items
- Work with New Product Development on engineering changes to minimize obsolescence
